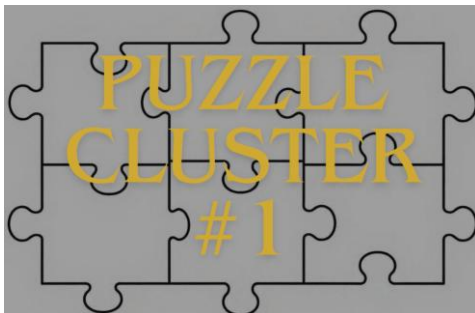




FATHER ABRAHAM HAD MANY SONS

- Revelation 7:9-10 is a passage that acts as a puzzle-box picture for seeing the big picture of God's mission.

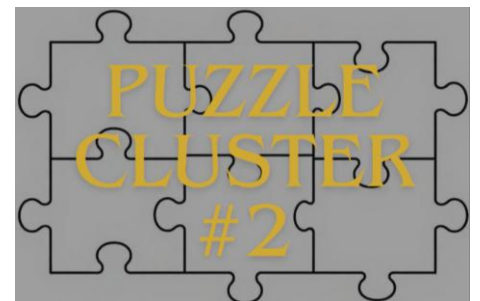


THE PROMISED SEED OF ABRAHAM

- Genesis 15:3-6 – Abram's *seed* would be like the stars of heaven.
- Genesis 17:4-5 – Abraham will be a father of many nations.
- God chose Israel to have the promise, covenants, prophets, and the law so that they could be a light to the nations.

JESUS, THE TRUE SEED OF ABRAHAM

- Israel failed their end of the covenant. Therefore, God would have to make a new covenant (Jer 31:31-34).
- Galatians 3:16 – Jesus is the fulfillment of Abraham's (singular) seed.
- Wait?!?! Abraham is to be the father of many nations, not just one Man? *Unless a grain of wheat falls into the earth and dies, it remains alone; but if it dies, it bears much fruit* (Jn 12:24).
- Galatians 3:26-29 – In Christ, you are Abraham's seed according to the promise.



Five Ways to Grow as “On-Earth-As-It-Is-In-Heaven People”



1. Believe in Jesus.
2. Consider being baptized.
3. Live your life with the puzzle-box-picture in mind (Rev 7:9-10).
 - Live as one who is of the seed of Jesus.
 - Put sin to death.
 - Be an on-earth-as-it-is-in-heaven person!
4. Share the gospel.
5. Pray for our missionaries and world missions.
 - Consider if God is calling you to be a missionary to unreached people groups.
